Dear Friends,

As we move forward in 2009, we will remember 2008 for the financial challenges that commenced, the partnership that was started and the journey to create the first elder abuse shelter in Rhode Island within the Saint Elizabeth Community.

With budget cuts to the Medicaid reimbursement system, and the difficulties of the financial markets, 2008 proved to be a year of unsettled financial times. To maintain our strong commitment to quality care and endure budget cuts with no staff layoffs, Saint Elizabeth Community reduced benefits and had to suspend cost of living raises. Nationally, the cost of caring for elders, (especially as the 65+ number grows), has created a dialogue that will be ongoing and surely effect some changes in the years to come. Saint Elizabeth Community will remain an active participant in the state and national dialogues.

Exploring the possibility of forming a partnership with Cornerstone Adult Services, Inc. was commenced in 2008, and in early 2009 a partnership was announced. This partnership is focused on shared values and the desire to create a seamless care system. Cornerstone brings the adult day component to The Saint Elizabeth Community's already established continuum of care, which has independent apartments, assisted living and nursing home care.

In 2008 much of the groundwork was completed to introduce the first elder abuse shelter in Rhode Island. Saint Elizabeth Community will provide shelter to elderly victims of abuse, for a short period of time, within its current residences beginning in 2009. Modeled after the first elder abuse shelter in the United States located in Riverdale New York, Saint Elizabeth Community has many partners in this initiative including state and local agencies and has great support from the Harry and Jeannette Weinberg Center for Elder Abuse Prevention in New York.

The Saint Elizabeth Community is enduring difficult financial times, but continuing to stride forward, keeping our mission in mind, as did those who lead this organization forward during difficult times in the past.

Saint Elizabeth Community 2008 New Projects

Cornerstone Partnership

Discussions with Cornerstone Adult Services about the possibility of a partnership started in April 2008. A transition team developed an agreement that is beneficial to both organizations and, most importantly, to clients. The goal is to create a seamless system of care where the client is served in the setting that best meets their current needs. Final affiliation agreements will be signed in April 2009 and at this time Cornerstone Adult Services, Inc. will become a member of the Saint Elizabeth Community.



Housing Services

■ A \$5,153,700 grant from HUD was awarded to Saint Elizabeth Community to develop a 34-unit housing complex with supportive services for low-income seniors. This project will be built in Warwick Neck adjacent to the Cornerstone Adult Services site and construction should be completed in the spring of 2011.

■ Saint Elizabeth Community is advocating for several housing programs that would offer an alternative to traditional nursing homes. Both programs require legislative changes to go forward; and we are lobbying state legislators and officials to promote these life enhancing residential alternatives:

- Green Houses[®] or similar small homes for elders on the grounds of Saint Elizabeth Home and Saint Elizabeth Manor
- Renovation of a ranch house on the grounds of Saint Elizabeth Manor in Bristol where four elders would live independently with support services provided by the PACE program. CareLink and Saint Elizabeth Community have been awarded a grant from the Rhode Island Foundation to assist in the evaluation of the project and will look into the possibility of additional sites.

Short term Rehabilitation

■ Rehabilitation has always been an important service for Saint Elizabeth long-term care residents. We are now expanding this service to individuals with various short-term rehab needs. Rehab may be necessary after surgery such as a hip or knee replacement, after a stroke or after an illness. Rehab services are provided in a fully equipped rehab room and short-term resident rooms include flat screen TVs and wireless internet access. Potential rehab patients are encouraged to visit with admission staff prior to their surgery to make plans for rehab at Saint Elizabeth Home in East Greenwich or Saint Elizabeth Manor in Bristol.

Elder Abuse Shelter: A safe haven for elderly victims of financial, emotional or physical abuse

■ Saint Elizabeth Community plans to offer shelter to elders who are victims of abuse. Scheduled to open in July 2009, the primary purpose of Saint Elizabeth Haven is to work with elders who are not safe in their homes. Individuals in need of shelter will be referred to Saint Elizabeth by domestic abuse workers from state and local agencies.

Saint Elizabeth Haven is focused on 3 goals: Caring, Education and Advocacy. Once the individual is secure at a Saint Elizabeth Community residence, we will work with the referring agency to plan for the elder's return to the community. Saint Elizabeth's goal is to offer the victim a short term stay and provide the medical, rehabilitative and social services that support the individual.

The program is based on a model from the Hebrew Home of Riverdale, NY. Rhode Island has no designated shelters for abused elders.

Staff training on the unique needs of elders suffering from abuse is made possible with a grant from the Mary Dexter Chafee Fund.

Funding issues

■ The 2008-2009 Rhode Island state budget includes cuts to the Medicaid reimbursement rate, specifically in how much the Home and Manor are reimbursed for labor costs. Since 70% of resident care is covered by Medicaid this means a loss of \$980,000. For the third year in a row, there has been no increase in reimbursement rates at the Saint Elizabeth Court.

■ To address budget shortfalls without staff layoffs, benefits were reduced and cost of living raises were suspended.

■ Eighteen beds at the Manor and 20 beds at the Home have been designated for short-term rehabilitation to increase revenue. Though there will be more turnover in our resident population the Medicare and managed care insurance rates that pay for rehabilitation is better than Medicaid reimbursement rates.



Charitable Giving

- The success of the **“See The Good You Can Do!”** 2008 Giving Campaign for Saint Elizabeth Community residents reflects the hard work of the Philanthropy and Employee Giving Teams and the generosity of donors. Gifts from grateful present and former family members; dedicated staff and volunteers; businesses and foundations made a critical difference and brought the year’s campaign total to \$422,889.
- As Saint Elizabeth addressed the challenges of diminishing state and federal funding of elder care services, philanthropic support continued to help maintain a vibrant level of programs and services. The Philanthropy Team, led by Linda Silveira and Dotty Wells, worked diligently to educate family members and others that the Saint Elizabeth Community is a not for profit organization that relies on charitable gifts to maintain what many proudly refer to as “The Saint E’s difference”.
- Saint Elizabeth Manor in Bristol received a \$56,900 grant from The Champlin Foundations to help replace the original windows and doors in the 30-year old building. We are grateful for this much needed improvement to the Manor.
- Kelly Cummings, chair of the Board of Trustees, was named Saint Elizabeth Community’s 2008 Partner in Philanthropy. Kelly was chosen for her many years of dedicated service and leadership.
- The 7th annual Rose Bids Gala Auction, chaired by volunteers Mark Kershaw and Mike Sutilla, surpassed expectations by raising over \$100,000 (after expenses). Teams of volunteers and staff members were proud to see that their efforts produced much needed income for 2009 programs including: spiritual life and pastoral programs; completion of a new Alzheimer’s living room area; new furniture and recreational/rehabilitation equipment.

Saint Elizabeth Manor - Bristol

- After 31 years of service, The Manor continues to undergo structural and cosmetic work to update the building. New retaining walls, landscaping, railings and lighting have been added.
- On a Spring evening in March a sprinkler pipe burst on the East Wing causing significant water damage. Staff quickly returned to the building to manage the initial clean-up and worked together to keep residents comfortable and safe during the cleanup.
- Short-term rehabilitation is in full swing at the Manor. The 18 “rehab rooms” have been outfitted with wireless internet access, phones, recliners and flat-screen televisions to meet the needs of those working on returning home after surgery. Additional nursing and social work staff are in place to meet the specialized medical care and reporting requirements of Medicare and private insurance companies.
- Staff began using Electronic Medical Records to perform the Minimum Data Set, which is the federally mandated clinical assessment of residents.
- Employees raised money to build a Pergola in the courtyard. The Pergola will provide much needed shade for the residents when they use the outdoor space.
- **“Journeys Ending, Journeys Begun”** a collection of prayers, spiritual practices, and suggestions for residents and families to enrich their final times together was created by Rev. Proctor. It is offered to them along with the use of CD players, a variety of music CD’s, books, magazines, and his pastoral care.

Saint Elizabeth Home – East Greenwich

- For the third straight year the RI Department of Health found the Home “deficiency free” in the annual inspection survey. Surveyors had many positive things to say about the way we provide individualized care to residents. For the second consecutive year, Saint Elizabeth Home has received the Statewide Innovation in Healthcare Award (Nursing Home division) from Quality Partners of Rhode Island. The award recognized the Home’s Pressure Ulcer Prevention and Treatment program.
- Additional custom made laundry hampers and resident bathroom shelving were made possible with the money raised through the employee giving campaign and the 2008 annual fund. After using the prototype cabinets for several months, staff made suggestions for improvements that were incorporated into the additional cabinets.
- An employee “go green” team led an effort for the Home to be more environmentally friendly. Styrofoam cups were among the first things to be eliminated; new faucet adapters on all common bathrooms which decrease water use by 80% were installed; recycling efforts have been refined and all old cooking oil goes to a company which recycles the oil into biofuel.
- Short-term rehabilitation has been formally introduced at Saint Elizabeth Home. Although the Home has always offered rehabilitation, three double and two single rooms on Unit 3 are now designated for short term stays. Telephones, 22” flat screen televisions and wireless internet access are available. A new rehab therapy area and additional nursing staff are in place to assist rehab residents with a speedy recovery and return home.
- Frank O’Brien joined the Home as the new Human Resources Manager. He brings five years of healthcare employment experience to his position. Jeannine Hinson, R.N. is the new nurse manager on Unit 3. She has worked in long-term care for 28 years and has a strong background in short-term rehabilitation.
- Optimus EMR (Electronic Medical Records Administration) went live on November 1. This is the next step in the Home’s electronic medical records system. It streamlines the medication ordering and administration process, further reducing our already low rate of medication errors, and reduces the amount of time nurses perform clerical functions related to the medication ordering process.



Saint Elizabeth Place - Providence

- Saint Elizabeth Place celebrated 25 years of service to seniors in 2008. Five tenants who moved there in 1983 are still there. The staff threw a party to celebrate the milestone and special recognition was given to residents who lived at the Place for 15 to 25 years.
- Tenants welcomed Jeanette Rolon as the new resident services coordinator.
- A new activity area was created by sectioning off a portion of the dining room. This popular room contains a 52" LCD television; a wall mounted electronic Bingo system and a Wii game station, all purchased with proceeds from the annual Rose Bids Auction Gala. Resident activities include a Wii bowling league; billiards leagues and weekly exercise classes conducted by a certified fitness instructor.
- ESL (English as a Second Language) classes are offered to residents starting at any level. They include: Beginners, Intermediate, Advanced and Citizenship Class. ESL conversational classes are also available.
- Carpeting has been replaced in the common areas of the eleven story building. Tenant's kitchens are being updated with new counters, refaced cabinets, and hardware.
- Project 20/20 came to the Place to provide tenants with an economic lighting alternative. The project was featured on the front page of the Providence Journal.

Saint Elizabeth Court - Providence

- Richard Frigon retired after 15 years of service to residents of the Saint Elizabeth Community. He was the administrator of the Place for over 10 years before accepting the position as the Court administrator.
- Dianna Shaw joined Saint Elizabeth as the Court's new administrator in August. She is a licensed assisted living administrator, a graduate of Simmons College and the University of Massachusetts.
- Court residents made good use of funds raised through Rose Bids' Fund-a-Need horticultural project. Wrought iron window boxes were purchased for the porch and entrance. Residents maintain the flowers and a small vegetable garden throughout the season. They also enjoy working with a professional floral designer each month to create flower arrangements for their apartments.
- Wednesday evening programs were introduced to give residents a mid-week night time activity. One of the favorites is a lively discussion group lead by program director, Karen Lewis.
- "Shake a Memory" bus rides have proven very successful. The rides give residents with memory loss an opportunity to reminisce about areas like "Down City," Providence. Residents enjoy seeing the old department store buildings: Gladdings, Sherpards, Cherry & Webb and Peerless!
- The Fifth Anniversary Party was attended by 175 residents, family, friends and staff. The food took on the "Country Fair" theme and visiting children enjoyed strolling magic acts and entertainers, a face painter and arts and crafts.
- The Court's dining service staff is working with students from Dorcas Place, a family and adult learning center in the Elmwood neighborhood of Providence. A student "shadows" a waitstaff person to learn job skills. Once the session is complete, they can be hired or they will return to Dorcas Place for further training or job placement.

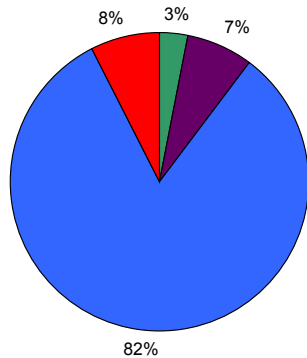
